

Yalm expands into two new ground floor units with a social gaming concept

Yalm is set to launch a brand-new concept on the ground floor as it knocks through into two adjacent retail units. The space will be open plan and extend from the existing ground floor and will be filled with more booth seating, two 18-foot-long shuffle boards and 3 bespoke made electronic dart boards.

The space has a unique design and provides for extra seating for those that already enjoy coffee and cocktails on the ground floor, as well as providing fully digital gaming options for those looking to something fun to do before or after eating at Yalm.

Food and drinks can be ordered in the same way as usual in the space, at the existing bars or using the QR codes and there will be gaming friendly menus from the vendors too. The games are technology driven with options for various gameplay and multiple users on both the Dart Boards and Shuffle boards.

The Shuffle boards will be bookable online by the hour and the darts bookable per person. There are also plans for various events, leagues and competitions as the space evolves. Like the rest of Yalm the space will be accessible and suitable for all, including families although the dart boards will be for 16+ only and the shuffle boards will require adults to accompany children for the bookings.

We are super excited to launch this space within Yalm, says operation director Dan Searle. We have been looking at ways to make the ground floor a totally unique space to upstairs and cannot wait to unveil the games we that have in store. They are being designed and built for us as we speak and will transform downstairs into a place to hang out with friends whilst enjoying everything already on offer at Yalm”.

An exact opening date and name for the space is still to be confirmed but it will be sometime in May and the space will be open from 10am – until late 6 days a week.
